Policy to withdraw Accreditation applications by Higher Education Institutions
(HEIs)

The Executive Committee (EC) in its meeting held on 14th May 2018, has resolved that

- For HEIs which have hitherto submitted their Self-study Reports (SSR) and wish to withdraw their application, they may do so before 1st June 2018.
- They will be eligible to apply to NAAC only after a year and their accreditation fee will be forfeited.
- The information pertaining to their withdrawal / non completion of the process should be hosted both on the HEI and NAAC website.

SSRs submitted after 1st June 2018

- the HEIs which have submitted their SSRs will not be allowed to withdraw from the process at any stage.
- If a HEI which has submitted its SSR, for any reason, does not complete the A&A process, the information that it has withdrawn / not completed the process should be hosted both on the HEI and NAAC website.
- The HEI will be allowed to apply for A&A only after a period of three years.
