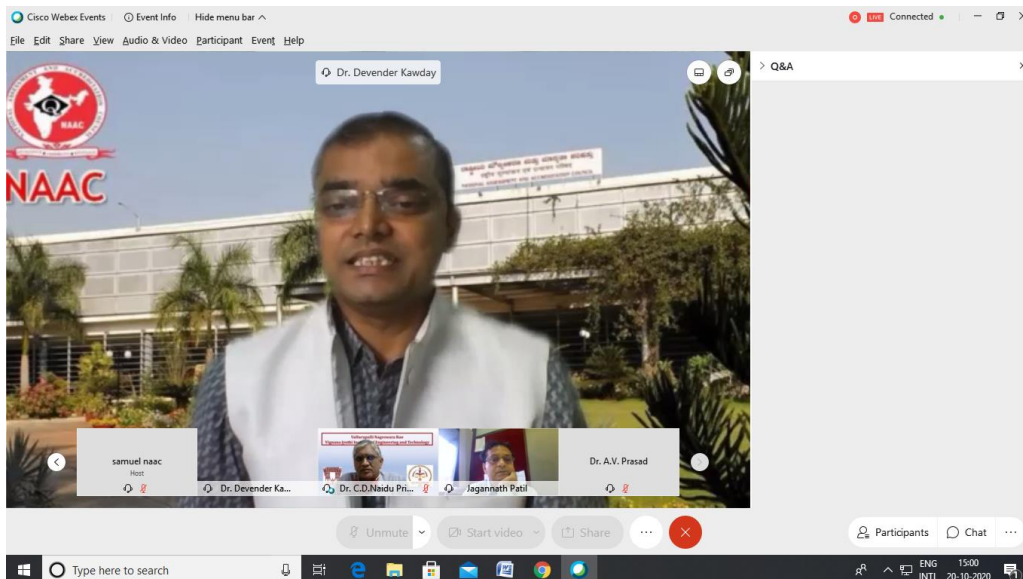
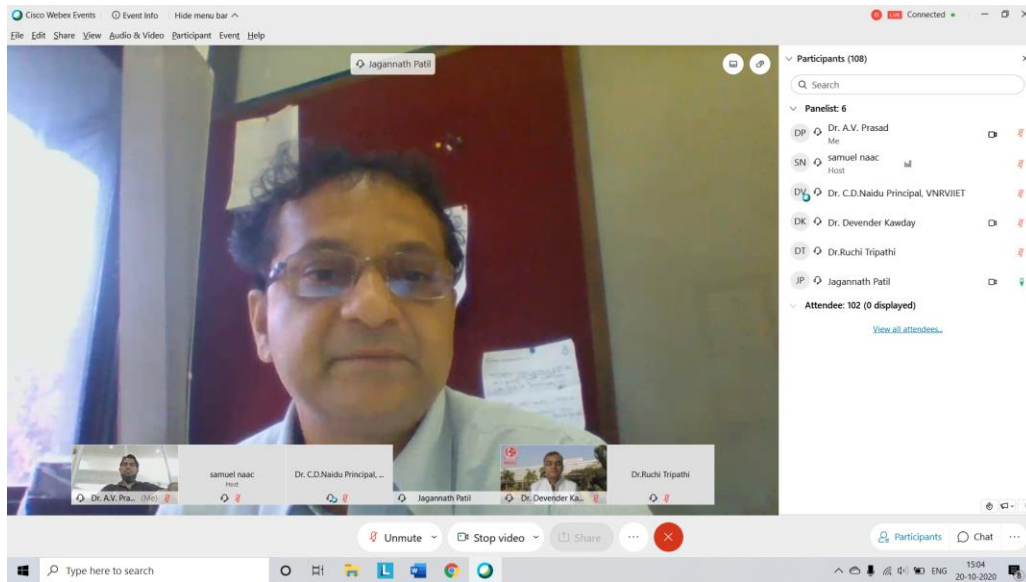

MULTIDISCIPLINARY EDUCATION

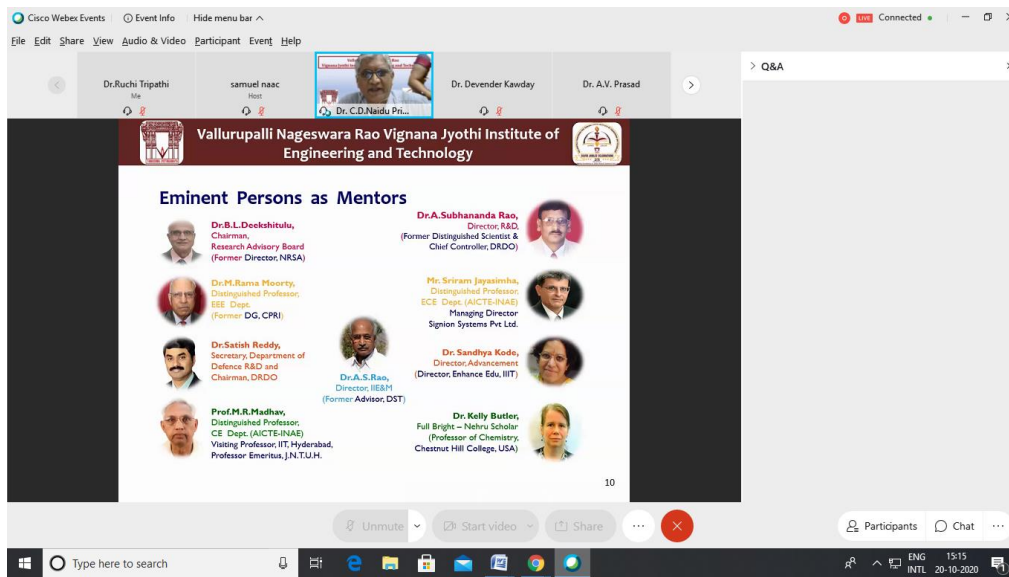

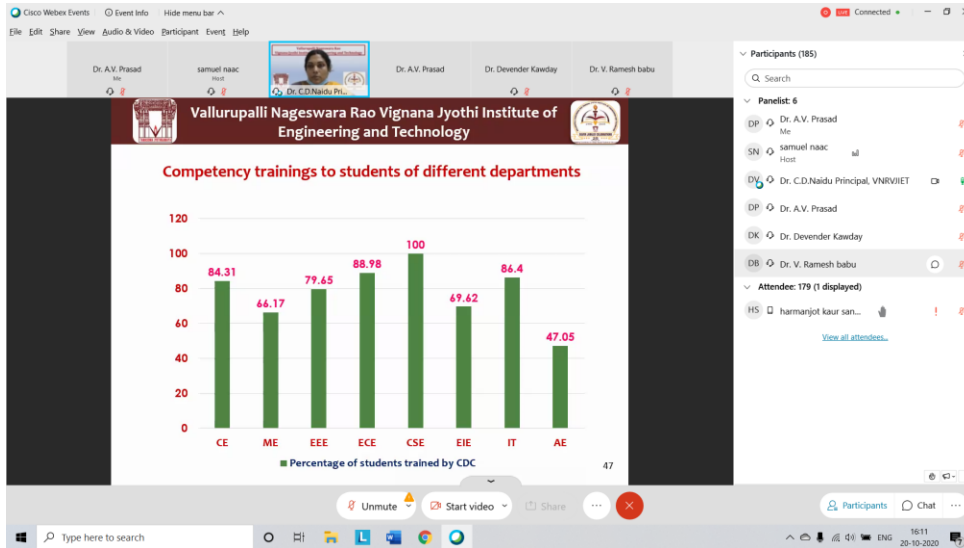
