

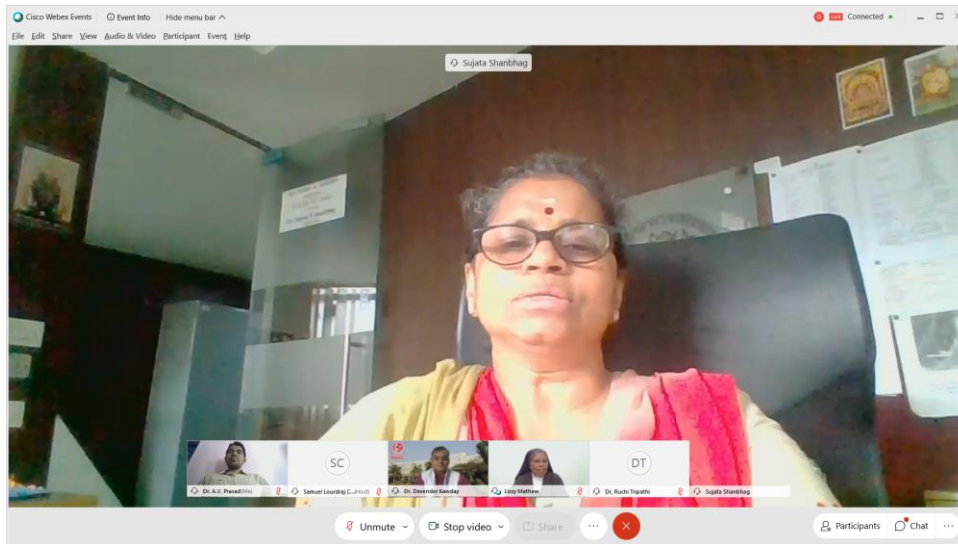

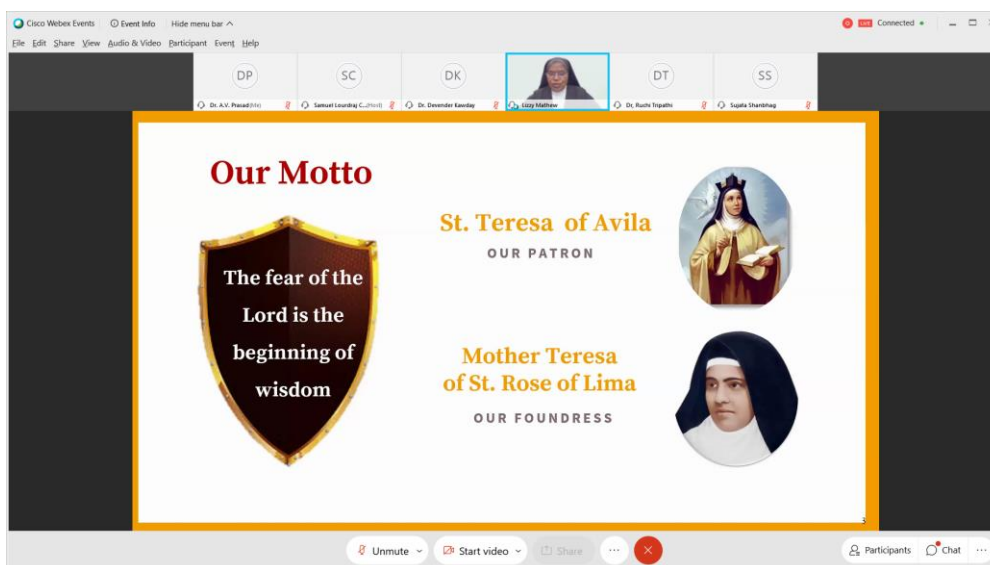


Further Dr. Sujata P. Shanbhag, Adviser, NAAC has provided thematic address on the webinar.

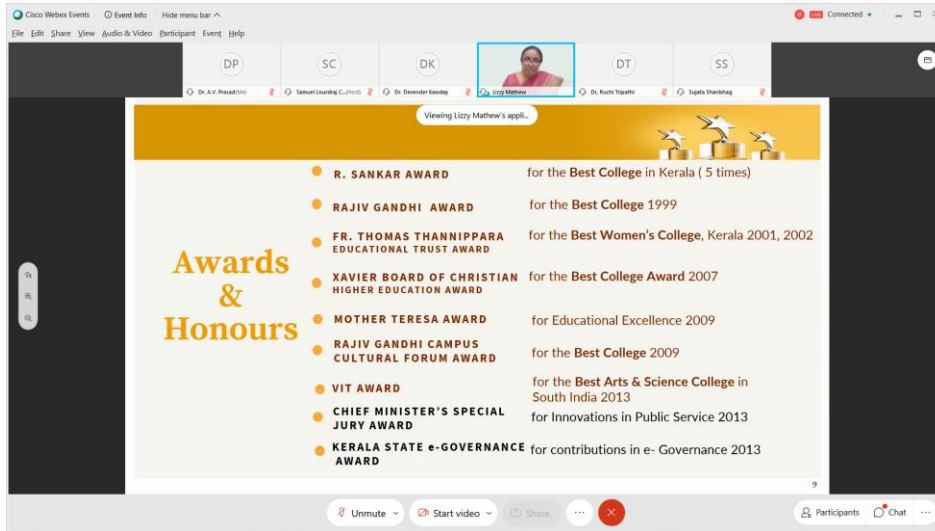

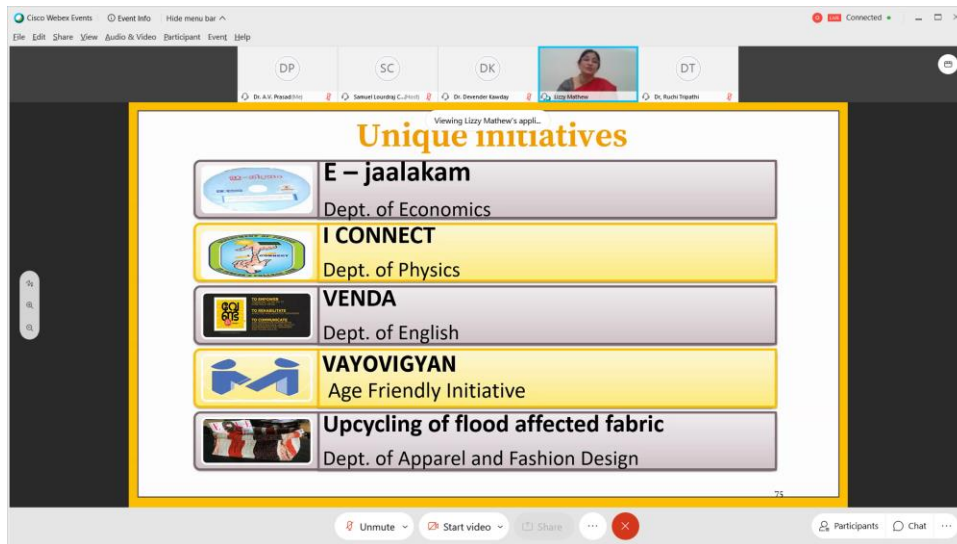
