

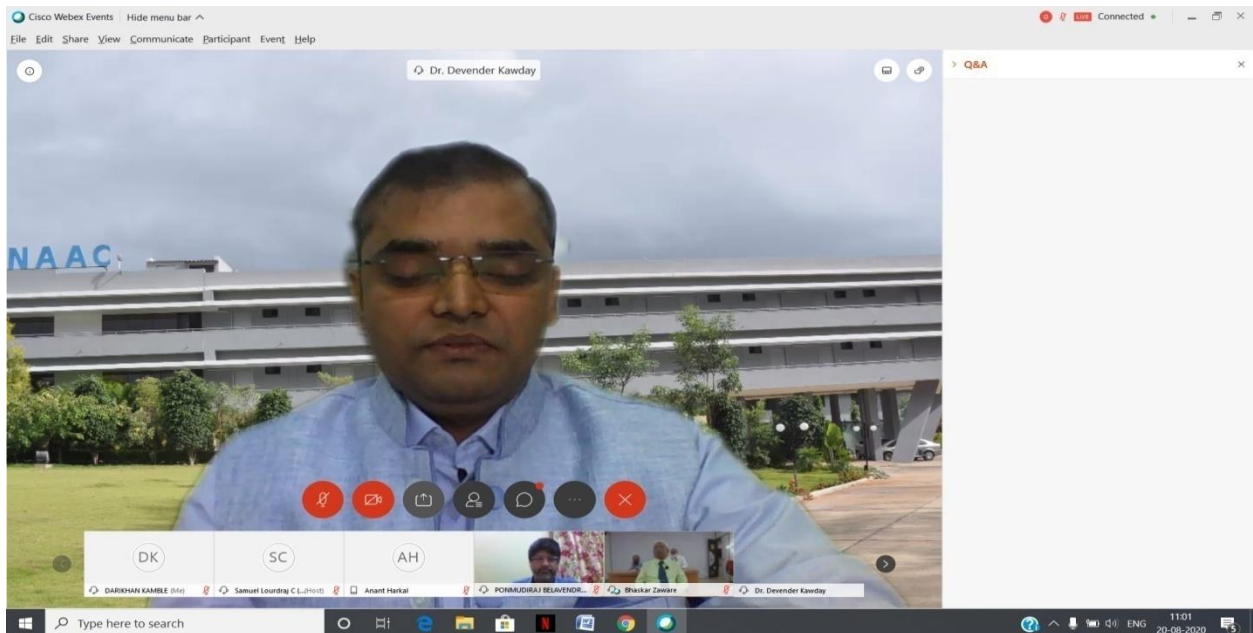

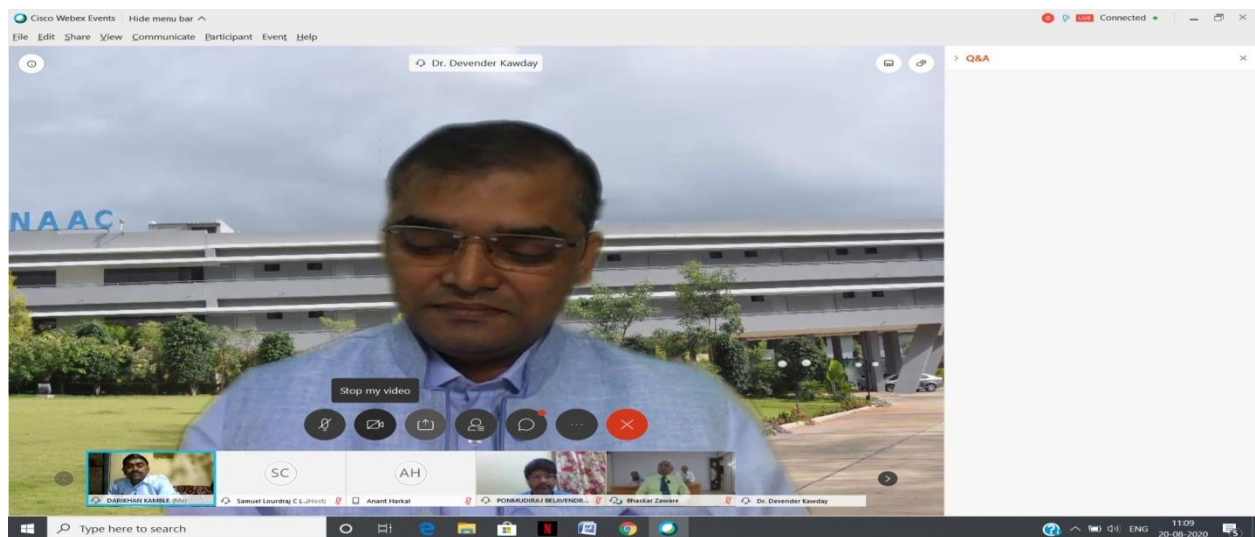
The webinar started at 11.00 am with the Welcome and Thematic Address delivered by Dr. Devender Kawday, Deputy Adviser, NAAC.
