EDUCATION"**

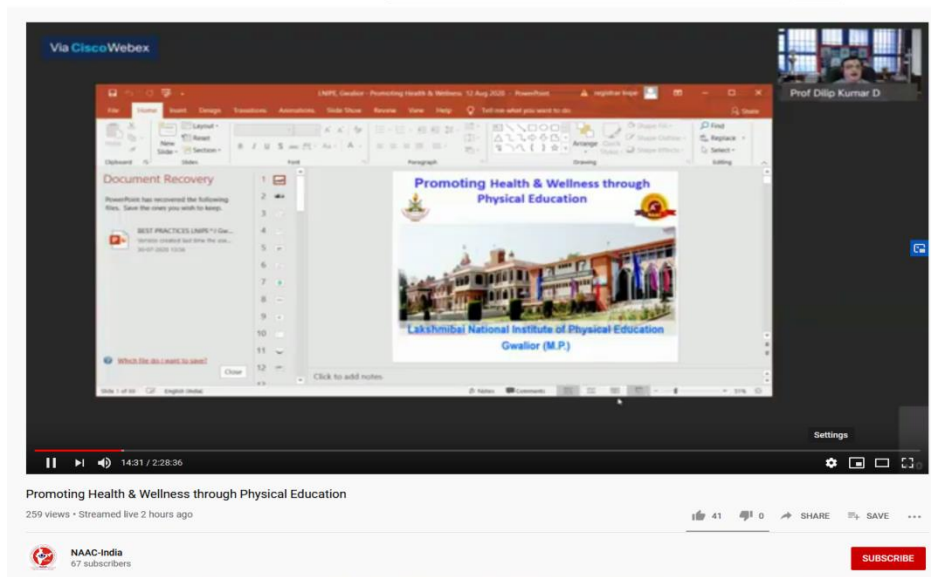
