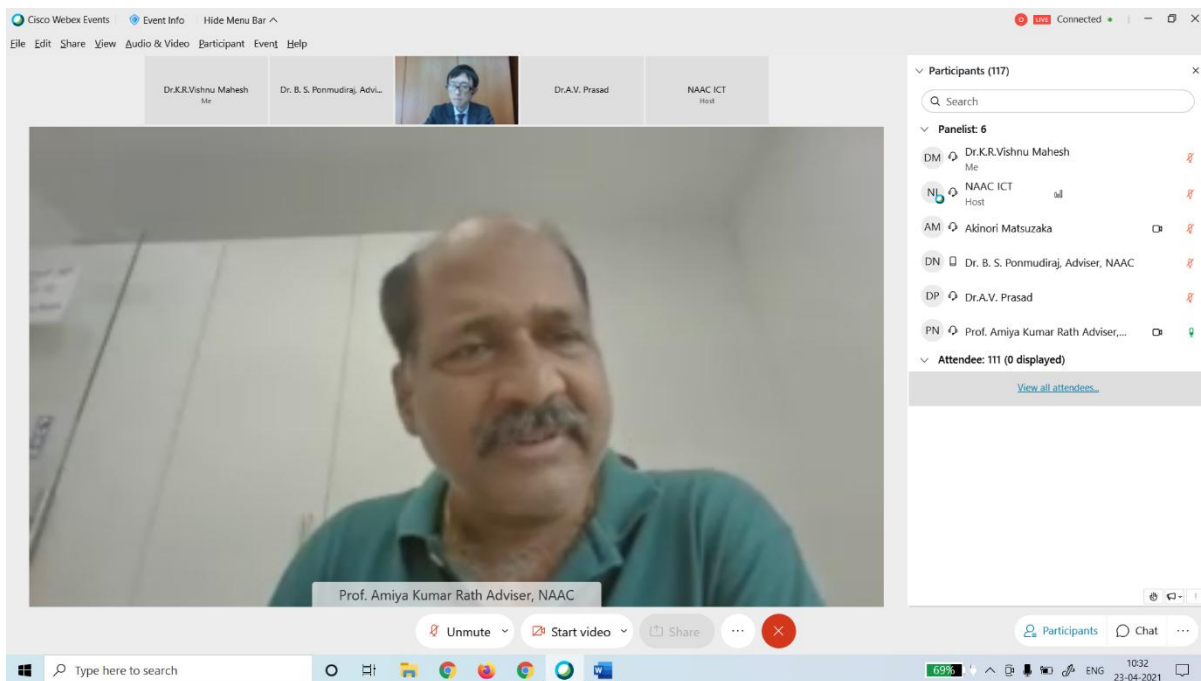


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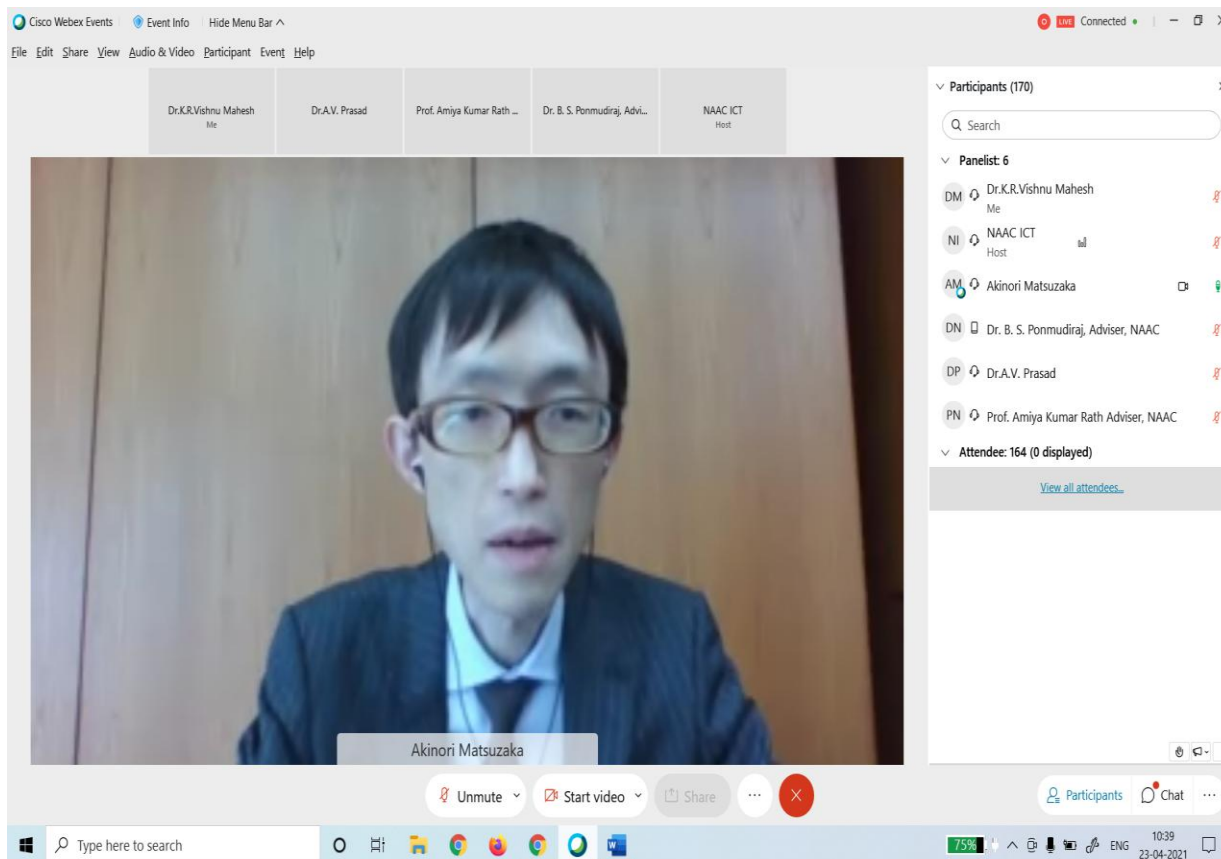
International Webinar on

“FOR ASSURING AND ENHANCING QUALITY: JUAA AND QA SCHEME IN JAPAN”

An International Webinar on the theme “From Quality to Relevance: **FOR ASSURING AND ENHANCING QUALITY: JUAA AND QA SCHEME IN JAPAN**”, organized by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bengaluru was held on 23rd April 2021, through video conferencing using CiscoWebex platform. The Webinar was organized with the aim of taking initiatives to reach out the Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) worldwide for quality improvements and quality sustenance and to Re-think Quality Assurance and Accreditation in the New 'Normal. Around 200 participants comprising a blend of National and International Academicians, Vice-Chancellors, Professors, Principals, IQAC and NAAC Coordinators from various institutions attended the Webinar. The Webinar started at 10:30 am with Welcome Address delivered by Prof. Amiya Kumar Rath, Adviser, NAAC.



Opening Remarks and details about the programme was given by honorable Prof. S. C. Sharma, Director, NAAC. Introduction of Resource Person, **Dr. Akinori Matsuzaka**, Associate Director, Research & Planning Division, Japan University Accreditation Association (JUAA), Tokyo, Japan and Bengaluru was done by Dr. A.V Prasad, Assistant Adviser, NAAC.



Dr. Akinori Matsuzaka, at the outset spoke about the current scenario about the higher education worldwide and the challenges posed to higher education especially during Covid-19 situation. He also stressed about the present teaching paradigm and the ways to improve it., In such a situation, the role of digital technologies and internet is noteworthy, but the digital equity is a concern due to digital divide, rural-urban division, operational difficulties etc. He also raised the concern about the economic contraction in terms of revenue, higher dropout rates, lesser international student mobility and teaching online globally. He also stressed on the role of Accreditation agencies in raising the quality of tertiary education and way forward.
