



REPORT OF VISIT OF NAAC REPRESENTATIVES IN BUNDELKHAND UNIVERSITY DURING JUNE 17-18 2022

In pursuance to the efforts of Hon'ble Chancellor of Uttar Pradesh to enhance quality of education in the higher education institutions of the state, a team consisting of two officials from NAAC headquarters visited Bundelkhand University for two day awareness program on quality indicators of NAAC evaluation. The team conducted interactive workshops and open discussion wherein the Deans, Heads of the Departments, NAAC Criterion Coordinators and Core team was educated and trained. Various doubts were cleared by the experts from NAAC headquarters. Following was the schedule of interactive activities and workshops

June 17, 2022

The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor welcomed the NAAC experts and introduced both of them to the present Deans, Heads of the Departments, NAAC Criterion Coordinators and other core team members assigned with accreditation activities. The IQAC Director and Coordinator described the background, status, features and unique salient points of the University in the form of power point presentation based on seven criterions of NAAC to the present experts. The present members from NAAC were satisfied with the performance of the university on all criterions. Dr. Vineeta Sahu, the NAAC expert made a detailed presentation on mission, objective and benefits of NAAC evaluation and process of Accreditation to the present faculty members and University NAAC criterion team. During Interactive Session after the presentation, various doubts raised by the present university faculty members were cleared by Dr. Vineeta Sahu. Various suggestions were also made by the NAAC experts to the present members including the top administration i.e. the Vice Chancellor, Finance Officer, Registrar and Examination Controller.

Dr. Neelesh Pandey delivered in detail about the DVV process, NAAC preparedness and logistics. His presentation was quite informative and encompassed all the aspects as to how to prepare and present the data for Self Study Report to ensure better grade. Both the experts made various recommendations as to how to improve on different parameters of NAAC accreditation. The interaction of the NAAC Officials with the Deans, Heads and Coordinators of the Departments, the Conveners of NAAC Indicators and Core Team of faculty members named as "NAAC Brigade" was quite beneficial and many innovative ideas generated from the deliberations and discussions. Various valuable suggestions were given to the faculty and staff of the respective departments by the NAAC representatives during the visit.

June 18, 2022

On 18th June, 2022 a workshop was organized for the affiliated colleges of the University to motivate them for NAAC Accreditation. More than 100 colleges participated in the workshop and interactive session. Resource person was Dr Neelesh Pandey, Assistant Adviser, NAAC.

The present Principals and IQAC Coordinators from the affiliated colleges were apprised of the revised accreditation framework. They were also apprised of the increased importance of various quality accreditations and certification, CBCS implementation and other changes under New Education Policy 2020. An interactive session was also held and the present college representatives expressed their willingness for NAAC accreditation. The present representatives from NAAC were informed that more than 25 affiliated colleges were accredited and approximately 20 were in process. One of the colleges was accredited with A Grade by NAAC.

The visit ended with the Valedictory Session presided over by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor and vote of thanks by Director, IQAC.
