One Day Workshop on NAAC Awareness Programme (NAP) was organized by Gulbarga University, Kalaburagi in collaboration with National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangaluru on 29th August 2022 at 10.30 am in the Mahatma Gandhi Hall, Administrative Building, Gulbarga University, Kalaburagi. This workshop was attended by teaching faculty and Principals/ IQAC Directors of affiliated colleges of Gulbarga University with a total participation of 214 registered through online and 91 registered through offline mode. All teachers of Gulbarga university, Central University of Karnataka, Affiliated, Private, Government college teachers of Gulbarga University Kalaburagi, newly formed Raichur University and Vijayanagar Srikrishnadevaraya University, Bellari were registered and participated in the One Day NAAC awareness programme.

Prof V. T Kamble, Registrar, and Gulbarga University welcomed the august gathering. Prof. B. R. Kerur, Director IQAC introduced the concept of NAAC awareness programme and its benefits including the modalities of the programme.
