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REPORT OF WEBINAR ON
“NAAC’S ASSESSMENT & ACCREDITATION PROCESS FOR COLLEGES OF RAJASTHAN”
14th JULY, 2020

With the generous encouragement and support from the NAAC, Bengaluru, the SLQAC of, Rajasthan organized a webinar on “NAAC’s Assessment and Accreditation Process” on **14th July 2020 at 10:30 AM**. Around 489 participants comprising of Principals, IQAC coordinators and members of IQAC from 153 Government Colleges and Sanskrit Colleges participated in the webinar.

The webinar commenced with an opening remark by **Shri Sandesh Nayak (IAS)** Chairman SLQAC, State Project Directorate (RUSA) & Director College Education. Wherein he extended his warm welcome to the participants and resource persons of the Webinar; **Dr. K. Rama**, Adviser, NAAC; **Dr. Devender Kawday**, Deputy Adviser, NAAC; **Dr. Shyam Singh Inda**, and **Dr. Vinita Sahu**, Assistant Adviser, NAAC. He emphasized that the State has sufficient focus on each and every aspect so as to meet the current requirements of the society and global standards in higher education. He appealed to the teaching fraternity to work collectively to improve quality of higher education in the state and to start preparing for assessment & accreditation process to get a good grade from NAAC. **Dr. B. L. Sharma**, Member Secretary, SLQAC introduced members of SLQAC and panelists from the state. He briefed the efforts of SLQAC for improving the status of accreditation of HEIs of the state.

Prof. Kanika Sharma, member and resource person from SLQAC underscored the requirement and importance of accreditation & assessment from NAAC. She explained the concept of RAF and its relevance in the present higher education paradigm in India. Prof. Sharma emphasized on the need for accreditation of the Colleges and institutes affiliated to the University. **Prof. Ashu Rani, Kota University, Kota** added that the NAAC Accreditation and Assessment process is very simple and portal developed by NAAC is very user friendly and it can be handled by colleges at rural level also. Almost all Colleges of Rajasthan are connected through Government e-portals for various activities like admission, e- content development, scholarship, student grievances etc. This facilitates the integrated development approach in all areas of NAAC accreditation. It was also proposed that to bring the different UG, PG and rural colleges under one umbrella, there should be some more relaxation by NAAC for Colleges of rural area or new colleges so that they can stand on the same platform where the developed PG colleges are.

Dr. K. Rama, Adviser, NAAC welcomed all participants and underlined the objective and rationale of the webinar. She explained the key components of the revised assessment and accreditation process in a very simple manner. She explained that 70% of the Accreditation and Assessment process relies on online mode and data submitted by the institution in quantitative metrics is verified and validated by third party- a Data Verification and Validation (DVV) partner. Dr. Rama advised to have proper documentation of all aspects related to Curriculum, Teaching-Learning, Student Support, Research, Infrastructure and Governance. She also explained about **do's and don'ts** which are to be taken care during the assessment and accreditation process. She emphasized that IQAC has an important role in improving overall quality in the institutions

therefore it should be made functional and updated in view of change in the process. She appealed to all stake holders to work collectively to improve quality of higher education so as to meet the current requirements of the society and global standards.

Dr. Devender Kawday, Deputy Adviser, NAAC elaborated upon the process of the Assessment & Accreditation and briefed about the concept of Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA), related documents to be submitted during IIQA process, the timeline to respond to the clarification and the process of registration by HEI. He explained the core values, vision, and mission of NAAC. He also explained the seven criteria; under each Criterion and Key Indicators involved in A & A process. These Key Indicators (KIs) are further delineated as Metrics which actually elicit responses from the HEIs. He also briefed about the optional metrics, its utility to the HEIs with related norms to be followed while opting the metrics.

Later, **Dr. Shyam Singh Inda** in his presentation explained the process for preparation of Self-Study Report (SSR). He highlighted the various components involved in SSR and types of questions asked in SSR citing relevant examples. He further elaborated upon the importance of SOP, reading manuals and glossary for better understanding of the metrics. Dr. Inda further explained the process of Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS), highlighting on the guidelines involved in SSS and efforts that can be made by the institution in reaching the desirable level and successful completion of SSS.

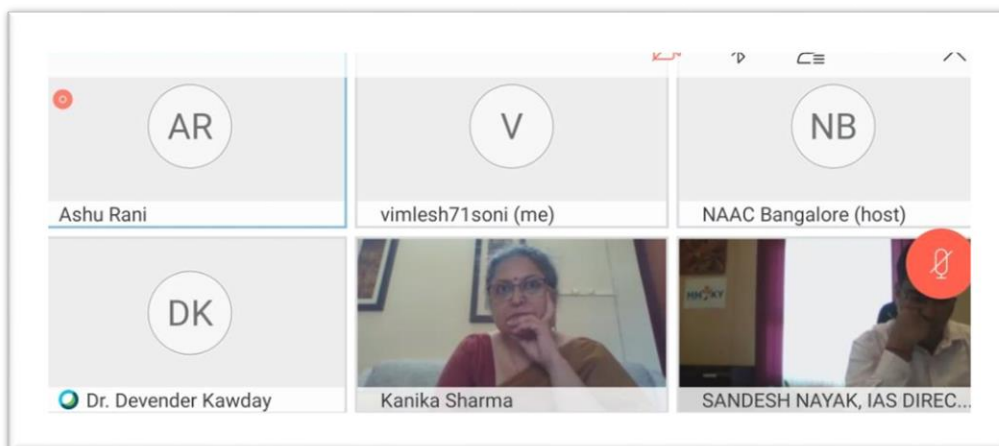
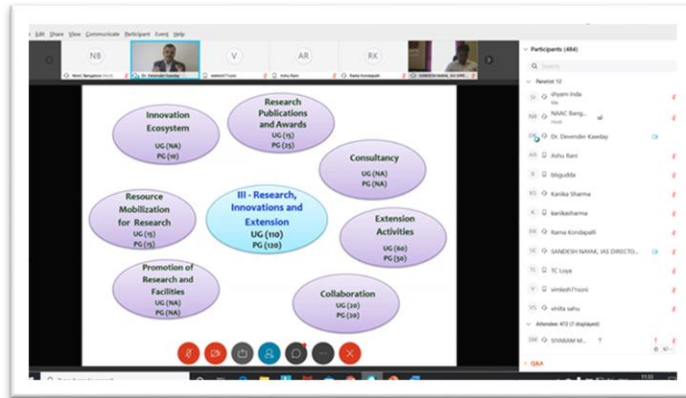
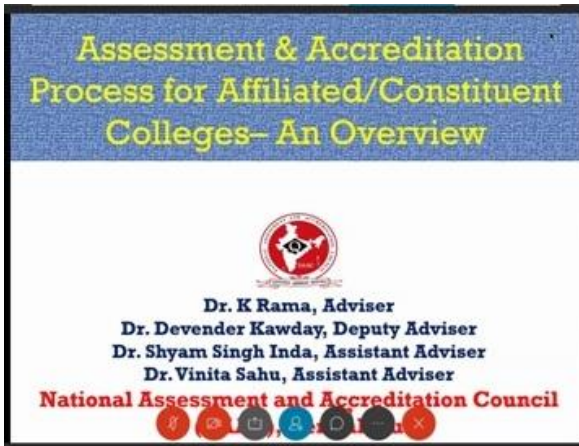
Dr. Vinita Sahu, Assistant Adviser, NAAC explained about **prequalification**, Data Verification and Validation (DVV) process, Peer Team visit (**PTV**) and Annual Quality Assurance report (AQAR). She emphasized standard operating procedures for DVV in ascertaining and validating the authenticity of submitted data and corresponding award of points to quantitative metrics. Dr. Sahu stressed on the importance of accurate submission and representation of all the required data for the claim made by HEI. Further, she explained in detail about the modalities of Peer Team visit (**PTV**) management on-site visit and Annual Quality Assurance report (AQAR).

Question Answer Session: Dr. K. Rama, Adviser, NAAC responded to the Questions and doubts raised by the participants. Principals & IQAC coordinators from various Government Colleges of the state discussed their difficulties and got their doubts resolved.

The webinar concluded with vote of thanks by Dr. Vimlesh Soni, Deputy Project Director (RUSA). He expressed his special gratitude to NAAC team and to the State Project Director (RUSA) & Director College Education for their constant encouragement in conducting the Webinar. He extended hearty vote of thanks to all the participants for making the webinar, a grand success.

'सभी विश्वविद्यालयों व कॉलेजों का नैक मूल्यांकन करवाने का करेंगे प्रयास'

जयपुर. राज्य परियोजना निदेशालय (रुसा), स्टेट लेवल क्वालिटी एश्योरेंस सेल व नैक के संयुक्त तत्वावधान में मंगलवार को एक्सीडेशन एंड एसेसमेंट प्रोसेस पर वेबिनार का आयोजन किया गया। उद्घाटन सत्र में राज्य परियोजना निदेशक संदेश नायक ने राज्य में उच्च शिक्षा की गुणवत्ता के उत्थान के लिए किए जा रहे प्रयासों की जानकारी दी। साथ ही कहा कि प्रदेश के सभी विश्वविद्यालयों व विश्वविद्यालयों को नैक मूल्यांकन करवाए जाने के प्रयास किए जाएंगे। वेबिनार में प्राचार्य व नैक प्रक्रिया से जुड़े महाविद्यालय के संकाय सदस्यों के साथ ही 153 राजकीय महाविद्यालयों से लगभग 500 प्रतिभागियों ने भाग लिया।

सरकारी कॉलेजों को नैक के दायरे में लाएगी सेल

जयपुर। राष्ट्रीय उच्चतर शिक्षा अभियान के तहत स्टेट लेवल क्वालिटी एश्योरेंस सेल रिकन्स्ट्रिक्ट की है। जो सरकारी कॉलेजों को अच्छी ग्रेड दिलाने में भागीदार बनेगी। मंगलवार को वेबिनार में कलेज शिक्षा के निदेशक संदेश नायक ने दी। राज्य परियोजना निदेशालय, एसएलक्यूसी और नैक की ओर से आयोजित वेबिनार में 153 राजकीय कॉलेजों से करीब 500 प्रतिभागियों ने हिस्सा लिया। वर्तमान में 292 राजकीय कॉलेजों में से 70 के पास ही नैक एक्सीडेशन है। नए कॉलेज से दो बैच पास होने या 6 साल पर नैक के लिए आवेदन किया जाता है।
