
Report on NEP - 2020 held on 13th November 2021 at 3.00PM through Virtual mode for the states of Madhya Pradesh and Dadra Nagar and Haveli

National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bengaluru organised a series of State wise webinars for sensitizing all Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) across the Country about NEP and bringing HEIs forward for NAAC Assessment and Accreditation process. NAAC conducted a Webinar on NEP – 2020 for the states of Madhya Pradesh and Dadra Nagar and Haveli from Western Region on 13th November 2021 between 3:00PM and 4:30PM. 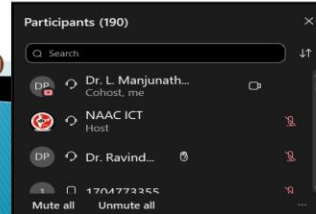
