Accreditation - Transition Autonomous Colleges (from 2014-15)

The NAAC has thoroughly analysed the results of institutions which are in the transition phase of autonomy and the following has been resolved:

1. For colleges which have become Autonomous from 2014-15, the NAAC may extend their existing Accreditation Status till they become eligible for applying as an Autonomous College, i.e., 5 years or 2 batches of students.
2. For all transition Autonomous Colleges, whose results have been declared under the RAF, an option is provided to extend validity period of their previous accreditation status (till they fulfill the eligibility requirement) or avail of the new Grade.
